It's that time again! Please note we will be voting for our provincial leadership. Below you will find the term of office and the offices that we will be voted upon. If you are interested in serving or have Silhouettes within your chapter who wish to serve, please advise them to contact me directly. Please find the outline of the duties, the functions and expectations of each office on the Provincial Level.

TERM OF OFFICE

The term of office shall be two Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Provinces, and each officer is eligible to succeed herself once when duly elected.

To be elected to a Southeastern Province Silhouette office, the nominee must have attended and have registered at two Southeastern Province Meetings within the three (3) year period immediately preceding but not including the meeting of the election at which she has been nominated; And must be in good financial standing with the Local, Southeastern, and National Silhouette body.

If an officer fails to function adequately, the coordinator, with the concurrence of the Executive Board, may advise her in writing that she will have thirty (30) days to explain such failure, and/or declare her intentions to explain her position. Failure to respond within thirty (30) days will result in immediate removal of said officer.

ARTICLE VIII - Duties of the Southeastern Province Elected Officers:

SE Province President:

It shall be the duty of the Southeastern Province President to preside at all Southeastern Province meetings, to appoint a chairman where needed, to appoint a Historian, a Scrapbook Chairman, and a Nominating Chairman. The Southeastern Province President shall be a member ex-officio of all Committees except the Nominating Committee. It shall be the duty of the Province President to assist in the organization of Silhouette Chapters where there are Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Chapters located within their Province. They shall be responsible for monitoring the activities of local chapters to assure compliance with national policies and procedures; and for promoting uniformity in accordance with the Southeastern Province Constitution and By-Laws.

SE Province Vice President:

It shall be the duty of the Assistant Province President to assist the President in discharging her duties and to preside at Southeastern Province meetings in the absence of the Province President. She shall assume responsibility for assuring the implementation of local projects by local Silhouette Chapters in the Province in accordance with Article II, Section 1 of the Southeastern Province Bylaws.

Southeastern Province Recording Secretary:

It shall be the duty of the Southeastern Province Recording Secretary to keep records of proceedings at all meetings and attend to all official correspondence.

Southeastern Province Assistant Recording Secretary:

It shall be the duty of the Southeastern Province Assistant Recording Secretary to keep records of proceedings at all meetings and attend to all official correspondence in the absence of the Southeastern Province Recording Secretary.

Southeastern Province Financial Secretary:

It shall be the duty of the Southeastern Province Financial Secretary to assist in facilitating the duties of the office of Treasurer. The Southeastern Province Financial Secretary shall keep current records of all financial members, receive all Southeastern Province dues and forward to the Southeastern Province Treasurer. She shall give an annual report and seat delegates at the Province meetings.

Southeastern Province Treasurer:

It shall be the duty of the Southeastern Province Treasurer to keep records of all money of the organization, and to collect and keep record of all money and monetary transactions. She shall be present at all Province Meetings. There shall be a financial report presented at each Province meeting. National dues shall be sent to the National Financial Secretary by the Province Secretary if requested at the Province Meeting.

Southeastern Province Parliamentarian:

It shall be the duty of the Southeastern Province Parliamentarian to render parliamentary decisions in order to keep the meeting running smoothly.

Southeastern Province Chaplain:

It shall be the duty of the Southeastern Province Chaplain to conduct all worship programs; and to open and close all meetings. The Executive Board reserves the right to determine whether the explanation is or is not acceptable.
